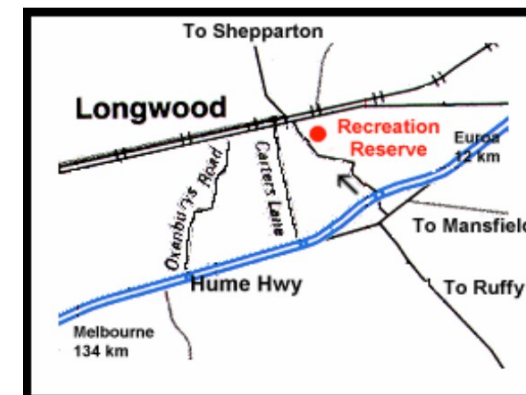

Conditions of Entry

- ◆ This event will be judged under the Rules for Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events effective 15th October 2020, and additional regulations as specified in this schedule. Drivers must be full members of the ACDS. Grading of horses is taken at the closing date of entries.
- ◆ The organisers reserve the right to: Alter the advertised times; Refuse any entry, with or without stating a reason; Measure any horse or pony; reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class
- ◆ Appeals must be lodged with \$50.00, with the Event Secretary within 30 minutes of the scores of each phase being posted. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
- ◆ Properly completed medical information bands are compulsory for all persons on a carriage; must be worn on the arm or the leg, and be visible, and are to be **worn at all times** when on a carriage.
- ◆ All Junior persons (being under 18 years of age) must wear an ACDS approved helmet AT ALL TIMES whilst driving or riding in a carriage at this event.
- ◆ Please Note: Only the horses/ponies listed on the official entry are able to attend this event without prior approval.

REFUND POLICY

Longwood Carriage Driving Club Inc. understands that circumstances may change, which have an effect on your ability to attend events / lessons that have been booked and paid for.

LCDC event organisers may consider a refund, only if a request for a refund is put forward with bank details included via an email to the event secretary prior to the commencement of the event.

Event organisers will use the following guidelines as a part of their review.

LESSONS

- LCDC are not able to offer refunds for pre-booked lessons, therefore a “no refund” policy applies including any related facility fee.
- If you are unable to attend your lesson, you are allowed to transfer your lesson to another person. It is your responsibility to ensure the LCDC organising committee is informed and has the new contact details of your replacement no later than 24 hours prior to the commencement of the lesson event. The lesson fee is then negotiated between yourself and your replacement.

COMPETITION

- If the LCDC event secretary is emailed a refund request **prior to the close** of competitor entries. A 90% refund will be provided within 4 weeks of the conclusion of the event. (10% of the fee is retained as an administrative fee).
- If the LCDC event secretary is emailed a refund request 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event a 50% refund may be provided. Your request to withdraw from the event must be in writing and supported by a medical or veterinary certificate to be eligible for a refund. The refund will be provided within 4 weeks from the conclusion of the event. (50% of the fee is retained as an administrative fee).
- If a refund request email is received later than 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event, NO refund will be given. The competitor then has the right to forward a refund review request to the LCDC Committee outlining any exceptional circumstances. This request must be lodged within 24 hrs commencement of the event, and will be reviewed and a determination made at the next LCDC Committee Meeting. A refund of not more than 50% may be granted.
- Should a competitor not be deemed ‘fit to compete’ i.e.: pass a vet check by the grounds jury no refund will be provided. It is the competitor’s duty to ensure their outfit is fit for competition.

COMPETITION ‘YARD & FACILITY FEES’

- Fees will be applicable as per event program.
- If a person/competitor applies to bring any extra horse/s to any events, and this is approved by the organising committee, but then chooses not to bring that horse for any reason, any fees paid are forfeited.
- If the LCDC event secretary is emailed a refund request prior to the close of competitor entries. 100% of the Yard and Facility Fees will be refunded within 4 weeks from the conclusion of the event.
- If the LCDC event secretary is emailed a refund request 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event. Yard and Facility Fees will be refunded at 50% and provided within 4 weeks from the conclusion of the event.
- If a emailed refund request is received later than 48 hours prior to the commencement of the event, no refund of Yard or Facility fees will be granted.
