

Conditions of Entry

This event will be judged under the Rules for Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events effective 15th October 2020 with any published additions, and additional regulations as specified in this schedule.

Drivers must be full members of the ACDS. All horses and ponies competing must be registered with the ACDS

Grading of horses is taken at the closing date of entries.

The organisers reserve the right to:

Alter the advertised times;

Refuse any entry, with or without stating a reason;

Measure any horse or pony;

Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class



Appeals must be lodged with \$50.00, with the Event Secretary within 30 minutes of the scores of each phase being posted. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.

Properly completed medical information bands are compulsory for <u>all persons</u> on a carriage; must be worn on the arm or the leg, and be visible, and are to be <u>worn at all times</u> when on a carriage. The Australian Carriage Driving Society recommends the wearing of back protectors, suitable for equestrian use.

It is compulsory for all drivers and grooms to wear protective head gear in all sections of the marathon. Head gear must be compliant with ACDS requirements.

All Junior persons (being under 18 years of age) driving or riding in a carriage must wear protective head gear, complying with the above standards, AT ALL TIMES whilst at this event.

Camping & Venue Facilities

Entry includes camping. Excellent toilet and shower facilities. Water and power but no powered camping sites.

Horses

Yards available or BYO yards. Yards are allocated on a first come first served basis. You must request a yard on your entry at \$20.00 per single yard or \$10.00 per horse for a shared yard for the duration of the event. All horses must be yarded in the designated equestrian area. Feed can be purchased in Euroa.

Please Note: Only the horses/ponies listed on the official entry are able to attend this event.

Dogs

No dogs allowed on grounds except on a leash. Dogs must be restrained at all times.
