DRESSAGE TESTS: Class 1 & 2 BB

Classes 3,4, 5 & 18 ACDS Novice A – Oct 2021

Classes 6, 7 & 8 ACDS Intermediate A – Oct 2021

Classes 9, 10 & 11 FEI 3*B HP1 Classes 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & 17 FEI 3*B HP4

All tests will be driven in a 100m x 40m arena

• Tests may be obtained from the Event Secretary.

MARATHON:

The marathon will consist of three sections, on grass tracks and quiet sealed roads with gravel/grass verges, up to 12 kms including 5 obstacles. There will be a shallow creek crossing on Section A.

Competitors are advised to have fit horses.

There will be no official marathon inspection.

The marathon course will be conducted on a **Share Stewarding basis**, ie: afternoon competitors will steward in the morning and vice versa. Each competitor is asked to provide one person for the share stewarding. If you are share grooming, sharing carriages etc, please ensure you advise of this on your entry form, so the organising committee can do their best to accommodate you.

Motor vehicles may be used to inspect obstacles but **are not** to be driven on adjoining private land.

CONES:

The Cone Driving will be conducted as a fault competition immediately upon completion of your dressage test. The course may contain a bridge.

ENTRY FEE: \$110.00 for all Classes.

CATERING: Free Welcome BBQ on Friday evening – please indicate numbers on Entry Form

No breakfast catering, but BYO and use club kitchen, please clean up after yourself.

Snacks, drinks and light lunches available

There is an **Event Dinner on the Saturday night**, if attending please include numbers

on your entry form

Free tea & coffee available all weekend

CAMPING: Showers & toilets – limited powered sites available

Powered sites \$6.00 per night Unpowered sites \$3.00 per night

YARDS: There are 26 yards available, with some secure for small ponies.

\$10.00 per yard for the weekend, please book on entry form.

BYO yards and electric fences are permitted – but not permitted at powered sites.

DOGS: Dogs must be on a leash at all times and owners must pick up after them, nothing

worse than walking in dog poo!

AWARDS: Sashes to third place overall. Ribbons to placegetters in each competition. Other

prizes may be awarded.

INDEMNITY: Neither Wingecarribee Shire Council, Moss Vale Pony Club, ACDS, private land

owners, SHCC or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft

or illness to horses, drivers, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This event will be judged under the Rules for ACDS Combined Driving Events effective 15 October 2020 and additional regulations included in this schedule. Particular attention is drawn to compliance with the Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse, which is a condition of entry to this event refer to Article 933.
- 2. Grading of classes is taken at the closing date of entries.
- 3. Drivers must be members of an ACDS Affiliated Club and must supply a copy of membership with Entry Form.
- 4. Competitors are aware of, and agree to pay, the applicable excess which applies to any insurance claim against the ACDS Insurance Policy which may arising from participation in the event.
- 5. Appeals together with \$50.00 can be lodged within 30 minutes of the scores being posted for each phase. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
- 6. Entry Fee must accompany your entry form, or a copy of your direct deposit receipt.
- 7. Competitors are to be available and provide one person to share steward as per the marathon draw/roster.
- 8. It is the responsibility of competitors to present themselves for a safety inspection 10 minutes prior to their marathon start time.
- 9. No refund of Entry Fee after closing date without Veterinary or Doctors Certificate.
- 10. All yards (own or on site) are to be left clean. Wheelbarrow & manure dump available on the grounds.
- 11. Prize winners who need to leave early, please organise collection on your behalf.
- 12. An able, responsible ACDS member must accompany all Junior Drivers.
- 13. The organisers have the right to alter any advertised times, refuse entry with or without stating the reason, measure any horse or pony upon discretion, combine classes or re-allocate a competitor to an appropriate class.
- 14. Competitors' kits will be available from the event office from 4pm Friday, 20 October 2023.
- 15. Prior to the event, a dressage draw will be sent to the email address you provide.
- 16. In the event of an accident or any other delay beyond the control of the competitor, please contact the Event Secretary as an alternative starting time may be arranged.
