



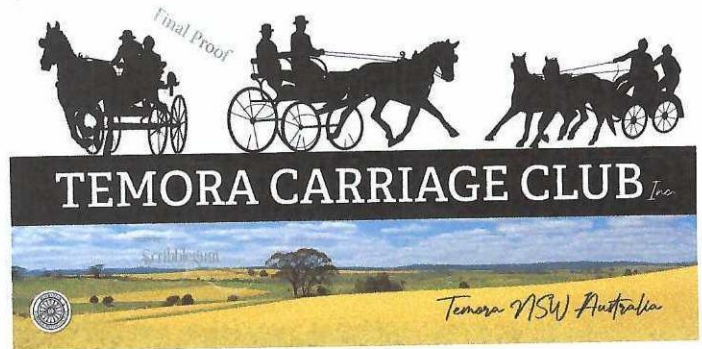

LOCATION 65 Keiths Rd Sebastopol, locality 15 km south of Temora on Goldfields Way.
The farm is nearly 1 km from the main road.

Join us for 1,2 or 3 days of competitive Endro Carriage Driving a distance of approximately 100km over 3 days for horses. An approximate distance large ponies 65 km or 50 kms over 3 days for small ponies. Weather may vary these distances.

Most routes are on unsealed dirt roads, state forest and some Hills. Returning each day to Rosymoon Stud.

Pleasure Drives are run daily after the Endro competitors have left.

Single day entries for any of the 3 days of events are available for both the Endro drives & the Pleasure drives.

Daily Endro ribbons awarded to 3rd place in all 3 classes.

Class 1 Horse over 149cm **Class 2** Large pony over 121cm n.e. 149 cm **Class 3** Small pony under 121cm.

3-day Endro entry \$110

Pleasure drives 3 days \$75.

Free Welcome Barbeque Friday night.

Self-catering, Barbeque and two fridges available in common area with seating and tables/AC. Tea and Coffee available free of charge.

No powered camping sites, use of shower and toilet facilities included in entry fee.

Limited yards available on first come basis must be included in entry. Plenty of room to put up your own fencing.

The following rules are for your safety and to make this event successful:

1. All competitors must wear a fluoro vest or fluoro clothing.
2. While on course please follow All NSW road rules and if necessary move over to the verge of roads to allow traffic to pass. This allows traffic to flow and keeps you safe.
3. Water stops are provided in safe areas off the road. Bring a bucket for your horse.
4. Halter and lead road MUST be carried on your carriage while on course.
5. First aide for Humans in a major case call 000.

8. Horse Ahead signs are placed at most intersections targeting high traffic use.
